What are the membership fees?

- ❖ Adult Riding Membership – Individual or couple 27 years or older and children up to age 23 residing in the same household – full hunting and voting privileges. \$1600
- ❖ Adult Non-Riding Membership – Individual or couple 27 years or older and children up to age 23 residing in the same household – full voting privileges . Two caps allowed per membership. May upgrade by paying the balance for the Adult Riding Membership. \$800
- ❖ Intermediate Riding Membership – For ages 23 to 27 and children. Full hunting privileges. If married, when one spouse turns 27, must convert to Adult Riding Membership. Nonvoting. \$600
- ❖ Junior Riding Membership – For individuals up to age 23. Hunting privilege is for the junior member only, but the family is invited to participate in social and club activities. Nonvoting. \$300
 - ❖ Dues are paid quarterly.

The formal hunt season kicks off the first Saturday in November with the Opening Meet and the Blessing of the Hounds. Riders don their formal hunting kit symbolizing the start of the regular hunt season.

The club continues to hunt on Wednesdays and Saturdays (some holidays too), normally starting at 10 am through midMarch. On Wednesdays, riders gather after the hunt for a tailgate social at their trailers, and on Saturdays, members bring an array of homemade dishes for the hunt breakfast. RIDING FIELDS

There are three riding groups, or fields, at most hunts. First field moves fast and jumps; Second field does not jump and moves at a moderate pace; Third field moves at a slower pace, no jumping. The fields offer riders of all abilities an opportunity to fox hunt.

JUNIOR RIDERS

Junior riders are always welcome to hunt. There are several Junior hunts each year which waive the cap fee and permit Juniors to ride with a Field Master, Whipper-In or the Huntsman. The club offers an attractive Junior membership plan.
